BIRTHDAYS



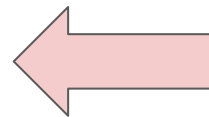
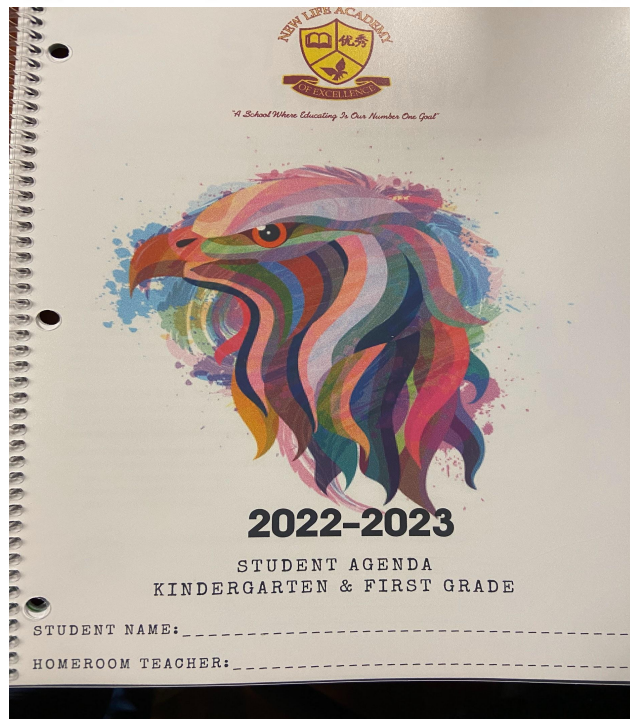
Due to the continuing pandemic procedures, we are limiting visitors. However, our students will still have a special day!

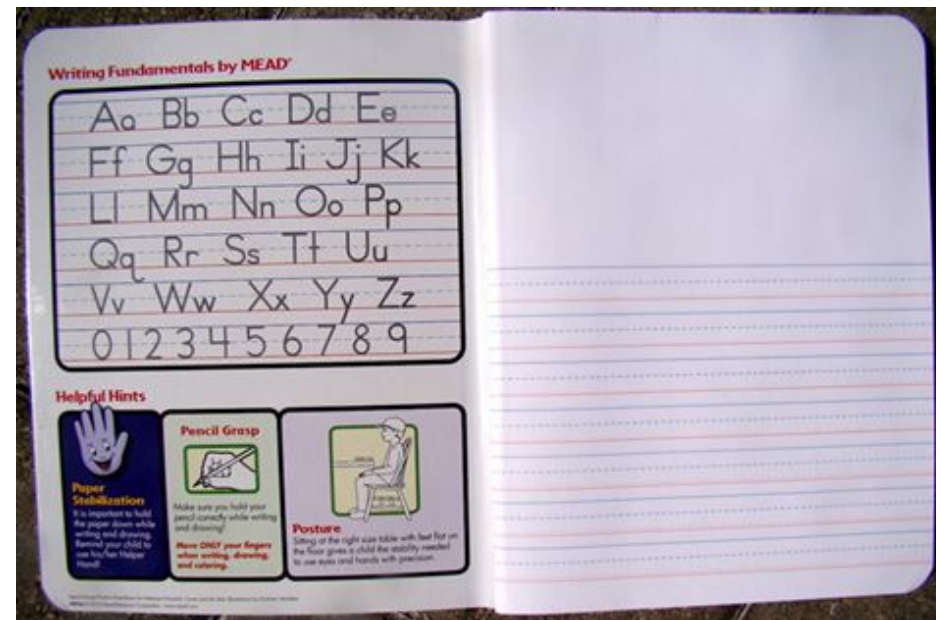
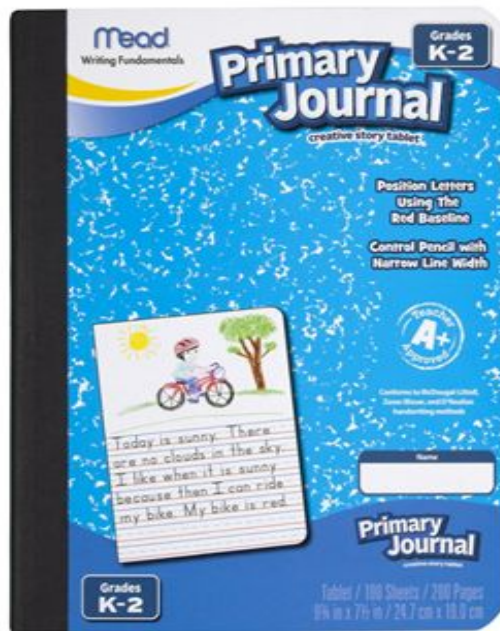
